Disease Management Programs

Our team of skilled nurses, medical social workers, nursing assistants, and therapists (PT, OT, Speech) work in partnership providing comprehensive care and education. We understand the importance of managing the symptoms of any disease or condition in order to maximize quality of life.

Our specialized areas include:

Congestive Heart Failure (CHF)

We help individuals and their families live with advanced heart disease by customizing a program that may include: medication reminders, education on how to help recognize early changes, and action to decrease episodes of serious illness.

Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease (COPD)

Our team will help you care for yourself and take charge of your COPD treatment. We offer education about medications and breathing exercises; education about clearing your airway; steps to reduce your risk for infection, and development of an exercise routine.

Hypertension

Our team helps you keep your blood pressure under control to reduce your risk of heart attack, stroke, chronic kidney disease and other related complications. We support your ability to self-manage through: blood pressure monitoring, diet consultation, and prevention strategies.

Diabetes

The goals for care planning for individuals with diabetes include treatment to normalize blood glucose and to decrease complications.

Personalized care plans may include: education in self-management and blood sugar and blood pressure monitoring.

Alzheimer's Disease

Our caregivers benefit from education provided through the Menorah Park Center 4 Brain Health™. Other support includes: physical therapy to improve balance; occupational therapy to support fine motor skills; speech therapy to provide cognitive assessments, and training to enhance thinking skills.

Falls Prevention

75% of falls happen in the home. Our team of home care experts can help you reduce your risk. We provide: focused assessment and support through physical and occupational therapy to reduce your risk and resulting hospitalizations from falls.

Stroke/TBI

Our program is designed to help each individual achieve the highest possible independence, while also supporting caregivers through education.

Parkinson's Disease

Our plan of care is tailored to meet the particular goals and needs of the client and family. Skilled nursing guides understanding of disease progression, provides medication education,

symptom management, self-management, and coping strategies with an included assessment for depression.

How Do I Qualify?

You may request home care by either talking directly with your physician or requesting a member of our staff to contact your doctor.

A patient may request services through the Medicare program through their physician (see patient criteria above). The patient has the right to choose which agency will provide services in their home.
